Control Health and Safety risks, protect employees and meet legal obligations.



What is ISO 45001?

ISO 45001 is an Occupational Health & Safety Management Standard that helps organisations to consistently identify and control the management of Health and Safety risks. This reduces the likelihood of accidents, reduces breaches of legislation and improves your Organisation's overall performance.

How do I become Certified?

Initially we will need to spend between one and two days on site assessing your current situation in relation to where the Standard requires you to be. Following this gap-analysis you will be issued a report, indicating any areas which require rectification prior to certification. Once these agreed rectifications are carried out and QMS have produced your Occupational Health and Safety Management System Manual, certification is usually possible within a few weeks.

Following certification, an annual surveillance audit is required to ensure your ISO 45001 Manual and Certification remain valid.
